ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSES FOR STUDENTS OVER 16 YEARS OLD

Entry level: it is made up of three different courses

PreA1 for scarcely educated students

A1 First approach to the language – at least 100 hours

A2 Teaching of Italian language for everyday use

Attendance in this course and the passing of the final test allow to apply for the long term residence permit – at least 80 hours

Intermediate level: it is made up of one course

B1 One-year course, 2 lessons per week of 2 hours each

Improvement of basic knowledge and more autonomous use of language

Courses will start whether the minimum number of students is attained. The assignment to the courses will be established by an entrance test to verify proficiency in Italian language.

At CPIA it is also possible to take the certification exam CILS (*Università per stranieri di Siena*) which is recognised worldwide.

Language levels mentioned above refer to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages
